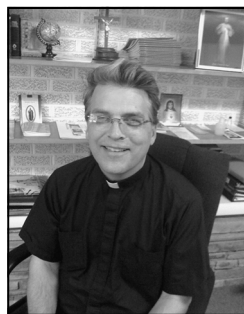

From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today is the Fifth Sunday of Lent. The images in the Church have all been covered indicating now that we are getting closer to the Holy Week and the time of special meditation on the sufferings and death of the Lord. Not seeing the images reminds us that we are depriving ourselves even of the joy of contemplating the saints who continually assist us here on earth. We will have to wait until Easter to see the statues and images once again.

Each week also brings us closer to the day that our community will celebrate the First Holy Communion of about a hundred of our children. Each new day also brings us closer to the celebration of the day that some of our young people will be confirmed. First Holy Communion Masses will be celebrated on three different occasions in April and May: April 29th at noon for those in 2nd grade. April 29th at 2:00 p.m. for those in 3rd and 4th grade. May 6th at 2:00 p.m. for those in 5th grade and up. Then, in June on the 18th there will be more First Holy Communion for the Latin Mass families. We rejoice in these celebrations knowing that all these children will be united with Jesus Christ in a special way in a Holy Communion. The Confirmations will take place at the Cathedral on May 4th at 7:00 p.m. and again on June 18th at the 10:30 a.m. Latin Mass. We are also anticipating the ordination of Erick Bell to the permanent diaconate. His ordination is scheduled for June 17th at 10:00 a.m. in the Cathedral and he will assist at the Masses the next day here at Sts. Peter and Paul. We are planning a special reception for him and his family on the 18th. Along with these special celebrations we also have many quinceañeros Masses and weddings on the schedule. Baptisms too are celebrated weekly on Saturdays at 1:00 p.m.

The month of April is already here and this coming Friday will be the first Friday of the month.

April 2 , 2017

We will have the same schedule that we had for the first Friday of March, that is, 6:30 a.m. Mass in Latin, 8:30 a.m. Mass in English with the school children, 3:30 p.m. Holy Hour for children, 4:30 p.m. Latin Mass, 5:30 p.m. Stations in English, 6:00 p.m. Soup Dinner, 7:00 p.m. Mass in Spanish, and then all night adoration for the various groups in the parish.

On Saturday, April 8th which will not be the first Saturday as that was last Saturday, we will have two practices for the servers. At 10:00 a.m. the English Mass servers will practice with Erick for the Holy Week services. At 2:00 p.m. the Hispanic servers will practice with Fr. Elmer and Sr. Blanca. The Latin Mass servers will have their own time as indicated by Craig Boyne. Next week will be a very important and busy week. I have already published the times of the services for Holy Week but will also post them on the door of the Church. We hope that everyone will be able to participate daily in the various services of Holy Week. God bless and keep you in His great mercy.

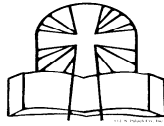

Hoy es el Quinto Domingo de Cuaresma. 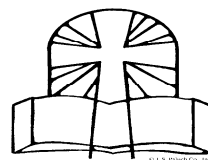
