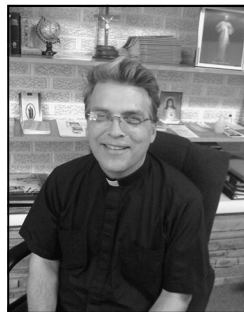

From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today on the liturgical calendar of the Church is the Feast of St. Magdaleno and companions. Among those companions who died as martyrs in Mexico is our own special Patron Saint of the Immigrants, St. Toribio Romo. Since today is also the Sixth Sunday of Easter the Feast of these Mexican martyrs is not celebrated liturgically. However, we at our parish certainly remember them and although the prayers and readings of the Sunday Mass have to do with the Easter Season we are aware that it is also the Feast of these Mexican martyrs. To celebrate this fact we would like to have an all day soccer match out in our baseball field. The players will come to the 7:00 a.m. Spanish Mass this morning and then begin their match. It should be a nice day of recreation for the whole community. You are invited to watch the players if you wish. The chapel of St. Toribio Romo honors not only the memory of St. Toribio but of the other martyrs of that same era in Mexico. There were many people who died during the persecution of the Church in the 1920's and 30's but those depicted on the windows of our adoration chapel are those the Church canonized by St. John Paul II. You may have noticed that there is a special display in the adoration chapel that depicts the faces and names as well as the Mexican states of those same martyrs. St. Toribio's relic is also displayed in the adoration chapel and is only one of two locations in the U.S. where his first class relic is venerated. Father Kirby gave me the statue of the Sorrowful Mother. It was made in Italy over 150 years ago. It is wonderful to be in that Chapel adoring the King of martyrs surrounded by the depictions of the "great cloud of witnesses who have washed their robes in the Blood of the Lamb".

Since Friday night, May 19th the community has been praying a special Novena to St. Toribio Romo to remember not only his Feast on the 21st of May but also to spiritually prepare for our Carnival of St. Toribio which will be next Sunday, May 28th. On that day (May 28th) during the Memorial Day weekend we will have the annual pilgrimage walk from St. Francis Xavier parish to Sts. Peter and Paul parish, a distance of about four miles.

May 21, 2017

The pilgrimage walk will begin at 8:00 a.m. next Sunday and we should arrive here at our parish around 10:00 a.m. We will serve food and drink beginning about that same time and outside bathrooms will be available. I am hoping that people won't feel the need to use the bathrooms in the Church so that the Mass beginning at 10:30 a.m. will be more peaceful. At 12:30 p.m. the Spanish Mass will be celebrated outside under a tent that will be set up for the occasion. The Carnival will continue all day with food, dance, music, and games for all ages. Let us pray for good weather!! This annual Carnival draws many people from all over the area, some of whom have never been to our parish. In some ways this is "remote evangelization" because sometimes these same people become interested in attending Mass and practicing their faith. I hope that everyone in our parish community will be feel welcome to come at least for part of the day and enjoy themselves.

On Thursday of this week (May 25th) the Church celebrates the Feast of the Ascension. We will have the 8:30 a.m. English Mass that day but the Feast of the Ascension in the Novus Ordo has been transferred to Sunday, May 28th, the same day as our Carnival of St. Toribio. But, in the Latin Traditional Mass the Ascension is celebrated on Thursday, May 25th. The Solemn High Mass will begin at 7:00 p.m. that day. There will be no Spanish Mass. However, special hand-outs will be available in Spanish and English and Latin to assist those attending the High Mass at 7:00 p.m. It is traditional to begin the Novena to the Holy Spirit on the following day for nine days in preparation for the Feast of Pentecost which is celebrated this year on Sunday, June 4th. I encourage everyone to mark their calendars and pray the Novena in their own homes, asking for the coming of the Holy Spirit anew on the Church throughout the world.

On Saturday, May 27th the Diocese of Tulsa will celebrate the ordinations to the priesthood of Rev. David Michael Webb and Rev. Peter Duy Vu Trong Nguyen. The Mass of ordination will be at 10:00 a.m. at the Cathedral. All are invited to attend this important event in the life of our Diocese. Later on Juan Angel Grajeda Gutierrez will be ordained on June 24th at the Parish of St. Michael the Archangel in Cocula, Jalisco in Mexico. Let us pray for these men who will exercise the priesthood of Jesus Christ in our midst that they remain ever

faithful to this holy ministry. And may the Lord increase the number of those willing to serve Him as priests. Chris Lopez from our community has been finally accepted as a seminarian of the Diocese and will be going to Dallas in August to begin his studies. It will take him eight years to complete the work and he will need our prayers to accompany him during those formative years. Congratulations Chris!!

It looks like it will be a busy week beginning today with the soccer match and I hope that all of you receive God's blessings on your families. May the Holy Mother of God pray for us.

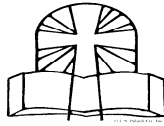

Del Párroco:

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Hoy en día en el calendario litúrgico de la Iglesia es la fiesta de San Magdaleno y compañeros. Entre los compañeros que murieron como mártires en México es nuestro propio Patrono de los Inmigrantes, San Toribio Romo. Puesto que hoy es también el Sexto Domingo de Pascua la Fiesta de estos mártires mexicanos no se celebra litúrgicamente. Sin embargo, en nuestra parroquia sin duda los recordamos y aunque las oraciones y lecturas de la Misa dominical tienen que ver con la Pascua, somos conscientes de que es también la Fiesta de estos mártires mexicanos. Para celebrar este hecho nos gustaría tener un partido de fútbol todo el día en nuestro campo de béisbol. Los jugadores vendrán a la Misa española de las 7:00 am esta mañana y luego comenzarán su partido. Debe ser un buen día de recreación para toda la comunidad. Usted está invitado a ver a los jugadores si lo desea. La capilla de S. Toribio Romo honra no sólo la memoria de San Toribio sino de los otros mártires de esa misma época en México. Hubo muchas personas que murieron durante la persecución de la Iglesia en los años 20 y 30, pero las que se representan en las ventanas de nuestra capilla de adoración son aquellas que la Iglesia canonizó por San Juan Pablo II. Es posible que hayas notado que hay una exhibición especial en la capilla de la adoración que representa las caras y los nombres, así como los estados mexicanos de esos mismos mártires. La reliquia de St. Toribio también se exhibe en la capilla de la adoración y es solamente una de dos localizaciones en los E. donde se venera su reliquia de la primera clase. El padre Kirby me dio la estatua de la Madre Dolorosa. Se hizo en Italia hace más de 150 años. Es maravilloso estar en esa Capilla adorando al Rey de los mártires rodeado por las representaciones de la "gran nube de testigos que han lavado sus vestiduras en la Sangre del Cordero de Cristo.

Desde el viernes 19 de mayo, la comunidad ha estado rezando una Novena especial a San Toribio Romo para recordar no sólo su Fiesta el 21 de mayo, sino también para prepararse espiritualmente para nuestro Carnaval de San Toribio que será el próximo domingo 28 de mayo. En ese día (28 de mayo) durante el fin de semana del Día de los Caídos, tendremos la caminata anual de

peregrinación desde la parroquia St. Francis Xavier hasta la parroquia Sts. Peter y Paul, a una distancia de aproximadamente cuatro millas. El paseo de peregrinación comenzará a las 8:00 de la mañana del próximo domingo y deberíamos llegar aquí a nuestra parroquia alrededor de las 10:00 a.m. Serviremos comida y bebida comenzando sobre ese mismo tiempo y los baños estarán disponibles. Espero que la gente no sienta la necesidad de usar los baños en la Iglesia para que la Misa comenzando a las 10:30 am sea más pacífica. A las 12:30 p.m. se celebrará la Misa española bajo una carpa que se instalará para la ocasión. El carnaval continuará todo el día con comida, baile, música y juegos para todas las edades. Oremos por el buen tiempo !! Este Carnaval anual atrae a muchas personas de todo el área, algunas de las cuales nunca han estado en nuestra parroquia. En cierto modo esto es "evangelización remota" porque a veces estas mismas personas se interesan en asistir a la Misa y practicar su fe. Espero que todos en nuestra comunidad parroquial se sientan bienvenidos a venir por lo menos durante parte del día y disfrutar.

El jueves de esta semana (25 de mayo) la Iglesia celebra la Fiesta de la Ascensión. Tendremos la misa inglesa de las 8:30 am ese día pero la Fiesta de la Ascensión en el Novus Ordo ha sido trasladada al domingo 28 de mayo, el mismo día que nuestro Carnaval de St. Toribio. Pero, en la Misa tradicional latina se celebra la Ascensión el jueves, 25 de mayo. La Misa solemne comenzará a las 7:00 p.m. ese día. No habrá misa en español. Sin embargo, habrá hojas especiales en español, inglés y latín para ayudar a los asistentes a la Misa a las 7:00 pm Es tradicional comenzar la Novena al Espíritu Santo al día siguiente para Nueve días en preparación para la Fiesta de Pentecostés que se celebra este año el domingo 4 de junio. Animo a todos a marcar sus calendarios ya orar la Novena en sus propias casas, pidiendo la venida del Espíritu Santo de nuevo a la Iglesia en todo el mundo.

El sábado 27 de mayo, la Diócesis de Tulsa celebrará las ordenaciones al sacerdocio del reverendo David Michael Webb y al reverendo Peter Duy Vu Trong Nguyen. La Misa de ordenación será a las 10:00 de la mañana en la Catedral. Todos están invitados a asistir a este importante evento en la vida de nuestra Diócesis. Más tarde Juan Angel Grajeda Gutiérrez será ordenado el 24 de junio en la Parroquia de San Miguel Arcángel en Cocula, Jalisco, México. Oremos por estos hombres que ejercerán el sacerdocio de Jesucristo en medio de nosotros, que permanecen siempre fieles a este santo

ministerio. Y que el Señor aumente el número de aquellos dispuestos a servirle como sacerdotes.
