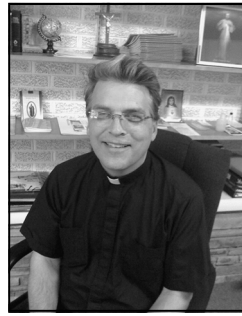

From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today the Novus Ordo Mass is that of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ. It is an important Feast and signals the time of prayer to the Holy Spirit in imitation of the Apostles. They waited for the Gift of the Holy Spirit and prayed fervently for His coming. And at Pentecost the Spirit descended upon those chosen men and filled them with courage and zeal for the proclamation of the Holy Gospel. So too we wait for the promised Gift of God's Holy Spirit and pray that we may also receive Him and be filled with the same zeal and desire to evangelize the whole world. Next Sunday the Church will celebrate the Feast of Pentecost and so let us prepare ourselves and pray for the whole Church scattered throughout the world. Christ has ascended to the right hand of the Father but remains with us always through the Gift of His Spirit.

This is also Memorial Day Weekend when we as a nation remember the sacrifices of countless men and women who gave their lives in defense of our country. May we never forget them. This is also a good time to thank our service men and women who are presently serving in the armed forces and to pray for them.

Finally we are also celebrating today the Feast of St. Toribio Romo, priest and martyr. His actual Feast day was last Sunday (May 21st) but it is our tradition to celebrate his special day on Memorial Day Weekend. And so today beginning at 8:00 a.m. there will be a group of people making a spiritual pilgrimage from St. Francis Xavier parish to our parish. The pilgrimage walk will be a time of prayer and song as well as dance. There will also be horses and riders to add to the festivity. At 12:30 p.m. here at our parish there will be a Mass celebrated outside underneath a tent and after that the games, music, food and dancing will continue until 10:00 p.m. The St. Toribio Romo Festival has become a tradition now in our parish as we are in our ninth year of doing it. It is a fund-raiser but also a time of fellowship and fun for the whole family.

Everyone is welcome!! Parking is available across the street from our baseball field at Pine and Sheridan.

We find ourselves already at the end of May!! This beautiful month of Mary is ending but hopefully our devotion to the Mother of God lives on and we continue to make the daily rosary a part of our lives. On Wednesday, May 31st we celebrate the Feast of the Visitation of Mary to her cousin Elizabeth. It is also my 32nd anniversary of priesthood. As I reflect back over those years I am filled with a deep sense of gratitude to God for the gift of Holy Orders bestowed on me through Bishop Beltran. There have been so many wonderful experiences and so many graces!! Please pray for me that I may live the rest of my priesthood more faithfully as God's servant. I hope that many other men will hear the Lord's invitation to follow Him in the way of the priesthood and respond with generosity to this most beautiful vocation.

Father John Kovalcin will be taking off the month of June and going back up to St. Louis. He asked that I not schedule him for Masses. Therefore, we are making some adjustment to our daily Mass schedule. Our Latin Masses will be celebrated on Wednesday and Friday mornings at 7:00 a.m. The English Masses will continue every day at 8:30 a.m. and the Spanish Masses will continue Monday through Thursday at 7:00 p.m. The only exception will be this coming Friday since it is the First Friday of the month. Father Elmer will celebrate a Spanish Mass at 7:00 p.m. this Friday.

Since it is the First Friday of June this coming Friday we will have the children's Holy Hour from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. followed by the Latin Mass at 5:30 p.m. The all night adoration by the parish groups will commence following the 7:00 p.m. Spanish Mass. On Saturday, June 3rd, the First Saturday, the Masses will be at 8:30 a.m. in English and at noon in Latin. There will be no Padre Pio Prayer Group following the English Mass. At 10:00 a.m. this coming Saturday I will examine the First Communion candidates and the confirmation candidates to see if they are ready to receive the Sacraments on June 18th when the Bishop comes to visit our parish. After the examinations I will distribute the Brown Scapulars to the children and then celebrate the noon Mass in Latin. That same evening Sr. Marleny will lead the Youth Group

members in a special Vigil of Prayer for the Gift of the Holy Spirit since it will be the eve of Pentecost. That prayer will commence at 7:30 p.m. followed by a small get together. It would be nice if everyone dressed in red next Sunday for the Feast of Pentecost. Come Holy Spirit!!

May God grant you each a great week and protect you and your family from all harm.

Calvary Cemetery

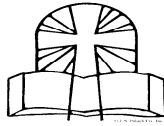
